## Bestellingen

Bol.com Integration for Magento 2

The Orders Grid shows all orders imported from Bol.com. Use it to monitor order imports, create Magento orders, and track the status of marketplace orders.

**Location:** Bol.com → Data → Orders

## Columns

---

Column	Description
<b>Bol OrderId</b>	Original order ID from Bol.com
<b>Account</b>	Bol.com seller account the order belongs to
<b>Magento OrderId</b>	Linked Magento order increment ID (clickable)
<b>Products</b>	Products in the order
<b>Total Quantity</b>	Total quantity ordered (hidden by default)
<b>Total Items</b>	Number of different items (hidden by default)
<b>Pickup Point</b>	Whether order is for pickup point delivery
<b>Shipping Address</b>	Customer shipping address
<b>Billing Address</b>	Customer billing address (hidden by default)
<b>Placed At</b>	When the order was placed on Bol.com
<b>Imported At</b>	When the order was imported
<b>Updated At</b>	Last update timestamp
<b>Error</b>	Error message if order creation failed
<b>Order Status</b>	Magento order status (if created)
<b>Status</b>	Import/processing status

## Toolbar Buttons

---

Button	Description
<b>Import Orders</b>	Import all new orders from Bol.com

Button	Description
<b>Import Orders Incremental</b>	Import only recent orders
<b>Create Orders</b>	Create Magento orders from imported Bol orders

## Mass Actions

---

Select multiple orders and use:

Action	Description
<b>Delete</b>	Delete selected orders from the grid
<b>Skip</b>	Mark orders to skip (won't be processed)
<b>Unskip</b>	Remove skip flag from orders
<b>Create Magento Order</b>	Create Magento orders from selected Bol orders

## How Orders Enter This Grid

---

Orders flow through two stages:

### Stage 1: Import from Bol.com

1. Cron runs "Import Orders" job
2. New orders are fetched from Bol.com API
3. Orders appear in this grid with status "New"

### Stage 2: Create in Magento

1. Cron runs "Create Orders" job
2. Imported orders are converted to Magento orders
3. Status changes to "Processed" with Magento OrderId linked

### Requirements:

- Account must have order import enabled
- "Import Orders From" date must be set
- Products must be findable by EAN/identifier

## Status Explained

---

Status	Meaning
<b>New</b>	Imported from Bol.com, not yet processed
<b>Processing</b>	Currently being converted to Magento order
<b>Processed</b>	Successfully created in Magento
<b>Error</b>	Failed to create - check Error column
<b>Skipped</b>	Manually marked to skip

## Manual Order Processing

---

To manually import and create orders:

1. Click **Import Orders** to fetch new orders from Bol.com
2. Review imported orders in the grid
3. Select orders to process
4. Use mass action **Create Magento Order**

Or via CLI:

```
bin/magento magmodules-bol:import-orders
```

## Tips

---

- Check **Error** column for failed orders to understand what went wrong
- Use **Skip** for test orders or orders you don't want to process
- Click on **Magento OrderId** to jump directly to the Magento order
- Filter by **Status** to see orders needing attention
- Import runs automatically via cron - manual import is for immediate processing
